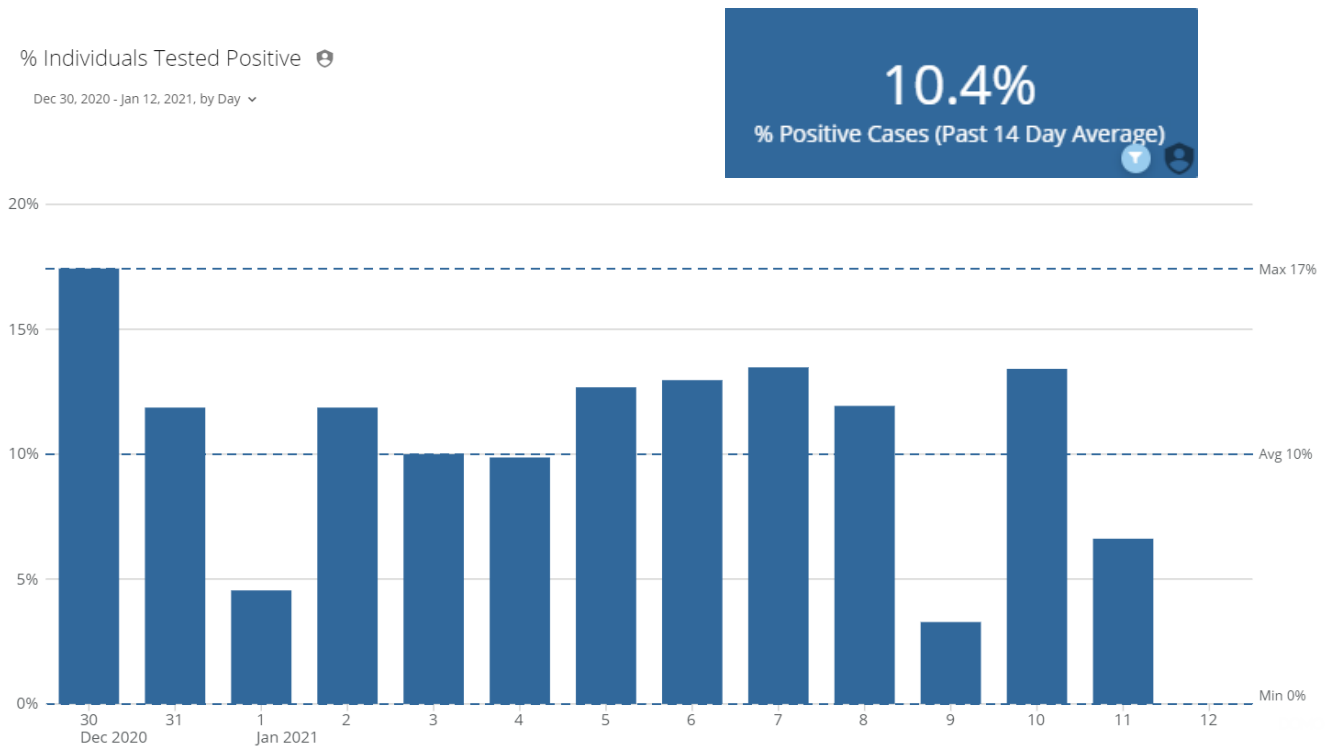
COVID-19 Joint Information Center Update

Data Snapshot (as of 10:00am)

- 299,892 total lab-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Iowa (01/13/2021).
 - 4,551 total lab-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cerro Gordo (01/13/2021).
 - 4,055 total recovered in Cerro Gordo (01/13/2021).
 - 431 total active cases in Cerro Gordo (01/13/2021).
- 4,232 deaths in Iowa (01/13/2021).
 - 65 deaths in Cerro Gordo (01/13/2021).

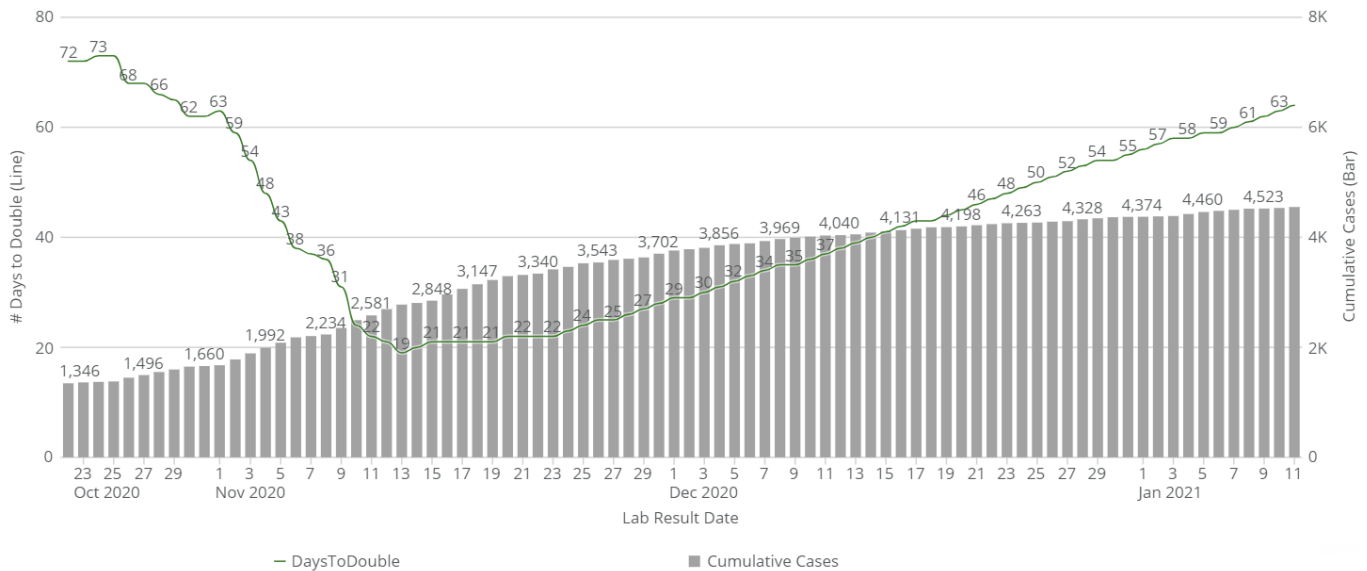


Days to Double
